Subject: Boating Safety

O R D E R

It shall be unlawful to operate any vessel in excess of 5 miles per hour or to create a hazaradous wake or wash within 100 ft. of the left shoreline or any structure, from the Corps of Engineers Little Bayou Meto Public Use Area on Mud Lake Bend, located in Jefferson County, Arkansas, to its confluence with the main channel of the Arkansas River. The restricted area as described above must be marked at 200 ft. intervals and 100 ft. from the shoreline or structures when the water level in Navigation Pool No. 2 is at 162 ft. MSL with bouys approved by the Corps of Engineers.

PENALTY: Not to exceed \$50.00
