Subject: Second Conviction

O R D E R

NEW CODE BOOK REGULATION: 100.24

The Court, in which a conviction of a defendant constitutes the second conviction of said defendant for a violation of any Arkansas Game and Fish Commission regulation where a \$50.00 or more fine is assessed within a period of twelve consecutive months, shall order the revocation of the defendant's hunting and fishing license and suspension of his or her hunting and fishing privileges in the state of Arkansas for a period of one year from the date of the second conviction, in addition to any other penalty the Court may assess.

Any person taking or attempting to take any wildlife or fish after his or her hunting and fishing privileges have been suspended, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00.

AMENDMENT: Regulation 70.09 (Code Book)

DUCK BLINDS AND OTHER STRUCTURES PROHIBITED. Unlawful to build or use permanent duck blinds, permanent deer stands or any other structure on any property owned or controlled by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission EXCEPT where specifically allowed by the Commission. Temporary deer stands may not be left overnight.


Subject: Boat Dock and Piers

O R D E R

AMENDMENT TO REGULATION - 71.05

- (Section 6) - Boat docks or piers (platform type) (not to include living quarters) for private riparian landowners and/or cabin owners may be constructed if written permission has been granted by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, said dock or pier shall not exceed 6' x 100'. EXCEPTION: A "T" may be constructed on the end of the dock or pier, but shall not exceed 8' x 16'; and may not infringe on an imaginary line of any adjacent landowner. The overall length of the dock or pier, including the "T", must not exceed 100'. Boat docks or piers must be open to the public and cannot be for the exclusive use of the landowner.
- (Section 10) - Structures must be inspected and permits renewed upon expiration of said permit.
- (Section 11) - DELETE: *(A riparian landowner and/or cabin owner shall assume all personal and property liability in conjunction with a structure on which a permit has been issued.)*



AMENDMENT TO REGULATION - 35.02

35.02 TRAP RESTRICTIONS. Unlawful to use any steel traps for trapping fur-bearers except smooth-jawed traps not larger than #2 traps. EXCEPTION: #4 smooth-jawed traps and conibar traps may be used in water sets only for beaver and otter.



AMENDMENT TO REGULATION - 35.04

35.04 SPECIAL TRAPPING. Unlawful to use any traps outside of legal fur-bearing animal season EXCEPT that a person may use any smooth-jawed trap up to #4 on land sets (and conibar traps in water sets only) on land owned or controlled by him to protect his property against wild animals when damage to crops or livestock is occurring. Any harmless or non-depredating bird or animal which may be caught must be immediately released unharmed. No license or permit is necessary.

AMENDMENT TO REGULATION - 10.05

10.05 LEGAL BUCK DEER. Unlawful to kill, shoot at, maim or wound a buck deer unless at least one antler is visible above the hairline EXCEPT in areas or seasons opened to the taking of any buck deer by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission. It shall be unlawful to possess or transport the carcass of any buck deer without one antler visible above the hairline in areas not open to taking any buck deer unless said deer was legally killed and checked in an area opened to the taking of any buck deer by the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, or deer was legally taken in another state.

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$500.00



AMENDMENT TO REGULATION - 20.05

20.05 ARCHERY PERMIT. Unlawful for non-residents 16 or more years of age to hunt deer or turkey with bow and arrow without an archery permit. If a kill is made, that permit must be filled out immediately thereby invalidating that permit for further hunting. Permit must be attached to the kill before it is loaded in any vehicle, boat or other transportation or before being carried into any residence, camp or storage facility. Non-residents may take other in-season game with bow and arrow on this permit until permit is invalidated. If a non-resident under 16 years of age kills a deer or turkey with a bow and arrow, he must immediately purchase a non-resident archery permit, fill out permit and attach it to the kill, thereby invalidating that permit. Failure to comply is a violation.

AMENDMENT TO REGULATION - 10.02

10.02 DEER CHECKING. Any legal buck deer killed during the gun season must be taken within 48 hours to a deer check station or to an agent of the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission for registering in the zone or county where killed. Doe deer or buck deer with antlers not visible above the hairline must be checked in the county where killed within 48 hours and before they are moved from the county where killed. Failure to comply with this regulation is a violation.
