Subject: Trap Restrictions

Amends Commission Order 005-74
Amends Code Book Number 35.02

O R D E R

Unlawful for any person to use, set, construct, possess, or tend, any steel trap, in this State, except smooth-jawed steel traps not larger than number two (#2) in size, except that number four (#4) smooth-jawed traps and conibear traps may be used in water sets in trapping for beaver. No traps so used shall be set in any path, trail or run-way commonly used by persons, domestic animals, poultry or dogs. And provided further that any steel trap set for the purpose of catching any fur-bearing animal shall be visited at least once each day and any catch therein removed therefrom. Provided nothing in this paragraph shall prevent persons duly authorized in writing by the Commission from possessing and using such traps as are ordinarily used in taking or catching coyotes, bobcats, and other nuisance animals.

PENALTY: \$50.00 to \$300.00

Amends Code Book Number 35.06


ORDER

Unlawful to possess, sell, or offer for sale the pelt of any fur-bearing animal 10 days after the close of the season for taking said animals except that a fur dealer having an established place of business in the State and possessing a current fur dealer's license shall be allowed 20 days following the close of the season on said fur-bearing animal to dispose of pelts. BEAVER PELTS MAY BE POSSESSED OR DISPOSED OF AT ANY TIME. It is further provided that any fur-dealer may apply for a permit to hold furs past the 20 days. Application must be accompanied by an inventory showing the number and kinds of pelts held.

PENALTY: \$50.00 to \$300.00

Subject: Special Trapping

Amends Commission Order 006-74
Amends Code Book Number 35.04

ORDER


Unlawful to use any traps outside of legal fur-bearing animal season EXCEPT that a person may use any smooth-jawed trap not larger than #4 on land sets* (and Conibear traps in water sets only) on land owned or controlled by him to protect his property against wild animals when damage to crops, livestock or other property is occurring. Anyone with written permission (on a form furnished by the Commission) on his person from the person owning or controlling the lands may engage in the activity as described above. All persons engaged in the above described activity EXCEPT "the person who owns or controls the land" is required to have on his person a current hunting and trappers license. Any harmless or non-depredating bird or animal which may be caught must be immediately released unharmed.

*Warning Signs furnished by the Commission must be erected in a conspicuous location when using #4 traps in land sets. It is the responsibility of the trapper to erect the signs as required in this regulation.

PENALTY: \$50.00 to \$300.00
