O R D E R

TRANSPORTING TURKEY. It shall be unlawful to possess or transport any wild turkey carcass without a current valid turkey tag being attached to one leg. Residents under 16 years of age and holders of valid Arkansas lifetime hunting licenses shall comply with Arkansas Game and Fish Code 15.10. Non-residents under 16 years of age shall comply with Arkansas Game and Fish Code 40.03.

Beards must also remain attached to bearded hen carcasses in gobbler only season. The tagged leg must remain attached to the turkey carcass until it has reached its ultimate destination.

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$300.00.

TRANSPORTING TURKEY. It shall be unlawful to possess or transport any wild turkey carcass without a current valid turkey tag being attached to one leg. Residents under 16 years of age and holders of valid Arkansas lifetime hunting licenses shall comply with Arkansas Game and Fish Code 15.10. Non-residents under 16 years of age shall comply with Arkansas Game and Fish Code 40.03.

Beards must also remain attached to bearded hen carcasses in gobbler only season. The tagged leg must remain attached to the turkey carcass until it has reached its ultimate destination.

PENALTY: \$100.00 to \$300.00.






